## Lady Indians 3-0 in Area following wins over Lakeview, Providence

### Indians suffer a pair of losses; will resume area play at Riverside Military Academy next week

The Towns County Lady Indians soccer team are currently 3-0 in area play with two Area 8 opponents remaining.

Last week they shut-out Providence Christian, 3-0 then held off Lakeview Academy, 2-1. Both victories are on the heels of a 9-0 blowout of George Walton on March 22.

Taylor Cornett led Towns County with three goals on the week - two coming in the win over Providence and one vs Lakeview.

Brooke Barrett also added a goal vs Providence and Lea Neumeyer had one vs Lakeview.

The Lady Indians are off this week for spring break but will resume action on Apr. 10 when they host Highlands, NC. The game of the week, however, will be Thursday, Apr. 12 when they visit Hebron Christian for a prime-time battle of Area 8 unbeatens.

The girls game at Hebron will take place at 7 p.m. following a 5 p.m. boys contest.

Hebron is currently 3-6-2 overall but 3-0 in Area play with a 5-0 victory over Lakeview, a narrow 3-2 win over Providence, and another 3-2 win vs Wesleyan on its resume.

As for the Indian men, they fell 5-0 to Providence and 4-1 to Lakeview.

They will also be in action on Apr. 10 when they travel to Riverside Military Academy in Gainesville.

Towns County will conclude Area 8 play when they visit Wesleyan on Apr. 17.

The Lady Indians will get underway at 5 p.m. with the Indians to follow. The Wesleyan boys are currently ranked 7th in Class A.
